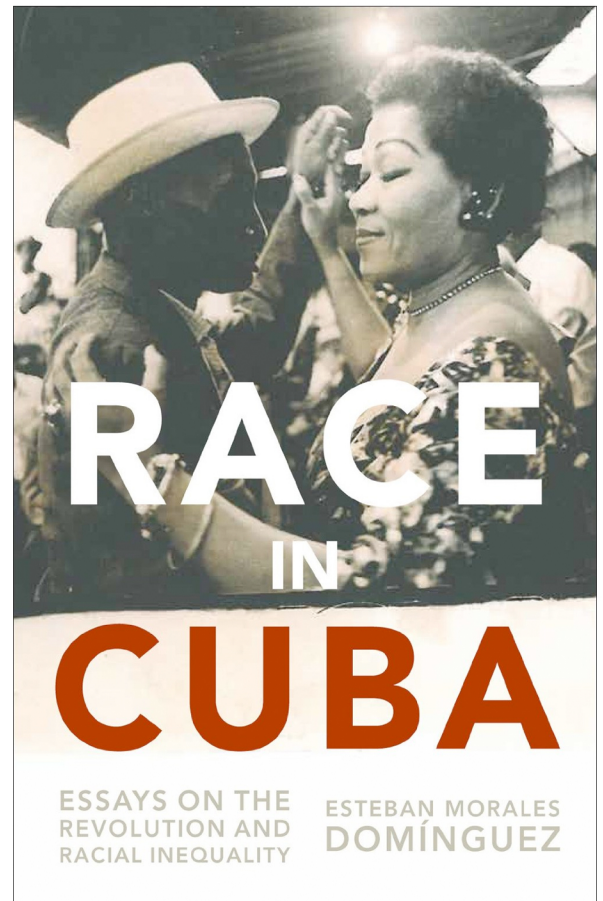

Prof. Esteban Morales Domínguez is a highly regarded scholar of race and racism in Cuba. His book, *Desafíos de la problemática racial en Cuba* or *Challenges of the Racial Question in Cuba* (2007), was the first academic book-length academic study on the topic of race written by a Cuban-based scholar to be published on the island after the 1959 revolution. With the 2013 publication of his translated essays in *Race in Cuba: Essays on the Revolution and Racial Equality*, Dr. Morales' work is now widely available to an English speaking audience.



Dr. Morales is Professor Emeritus of Political Economy in the University of Havana. He was a member of the Aponte Commission to Combat Racism of UNEAC (Cuban national association of writers & artists). Prof. Morales has been recognized by the Cuban Academy of Sciences and the Ministry of Higher Education.
