Preparations are well under way for the fall season, and I want to personally extend an invitation to you and your family to attend the homecoming activities—and there are *many*! This year marks the 100th anniversary of BGSU’s College of Music. This homecoming will be Dr. Carol Hayward’s last as Director of the Falcon Marching Band, as she is retiring next spring. You don’t have to go far to discover (if by some chance you didn’t already know!) the impact that Dr. Hayward has had on bands, the Falcon Marching Band and music education at BGSU. The sounds, the discipline, the excitement, the movement, the design, the impact of the FMB – all part of Carol’s vision when she began at BGSU 12 years ago. I think you’ll agree that she has succeeded beautifully on all counts and more. The performances of the FMB are absolutely outstanding, and you are guaranteed yet another on Homecoming this October 4. To remember Dr. Hayward’s first season with the FMB in 2003, the band will reprise the epic “Frontiers.” This monumental work was the first of what would be several original compositions for the Falcon Marching Band by Ryan Nowlin. This music has become a part of the fabric of the band’s tradition, and all who remember it or have heard about it will want to take the opportunity to experience it live once again!

We are due for an *Alumni Concert Band reunion*, and with this being the 100th anniversary of the CMA, and a very special homecoming for Dr. Hayward, we are combining all events on Homecoming week-end. Plan to join us on both Saturday October 4 and Sunday, October 5 for the festivities. The Homecoming game will be Saturday (time to be determined due to potential television coverage – more on that in this newsletter).

The *Alumni Concert Band* will rehearse and perform on Sunday, October 5 with the BGSU Wind Symphony. Rehearsal will begin at 12:00 noon, with a break (snacks provided) prior to performing with

the BGSU Wind Symphony at 3:00 pm on this day. It is important that you return the enclosed intent to perform information so that specific details and music can be sent to you via U.S. mail prior to the event. We hope to get many alumni back for this “sit-down band” performance, and you are welcome if you ever played in the University Band, the Concert Band, the Wind Symphony/Symphonic Band or the Falcon Marching Band. Make this 100th anniversary of the CMA and Dr. Hayward’s final homecoming the time that *YOU* make it back to zip code 43403! We are counting on you!
